1. Useful English Presentation Phrases

Phrases to remind your audience why the topic and ideas of your presentation are important and keep them focused:

Phrase 1: "As I said at the beginning..."

Phrase 2: "As you may remember, we are concerned with..."

Phrase 3: "This ties in with my original statement..."

Phrase 4: "This relates directly to the question I put to you before..."

...reminding your audience of how your ideas and topics are connected helps them to stay interested and attentive...

When you present, at first your audience is given a lot of new information about who you are and mostly about your topic. This is a lot to remember, especially if your topic is completely new to them. At about the middle of your speech try to help your audience by reminding them what your original thesis, questions or problems are that have led you to give this presentation. Even if some attendees remember everything it will help those that are a bit overwhelmed with the complexity of your topic. Overall, your audience will gain better understanding by giving them some memory support.

It will allow you to present your content in a manner your audience can relate to.
